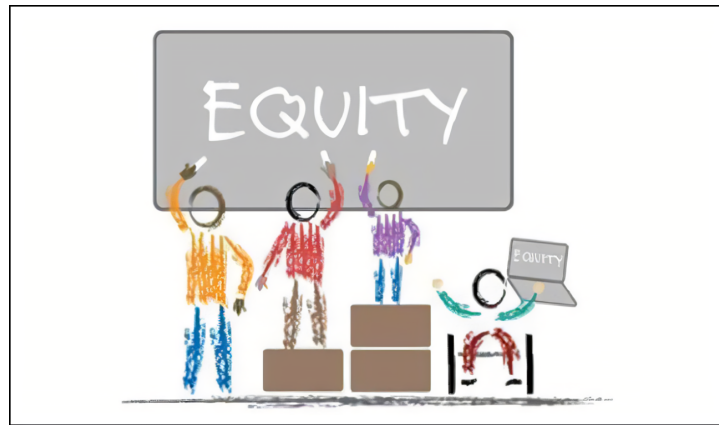




“Impact on Equity: How Will the CMS Comprehensive Plan Improve Educational Opportunities for ALL Students?”
