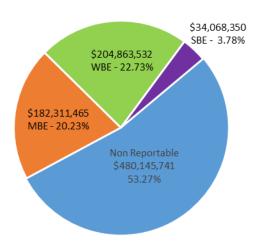

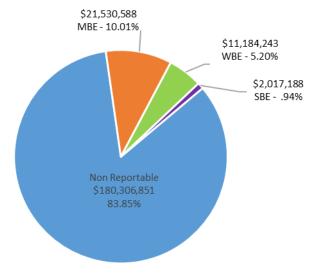


#### **MWSBE Participation**

The MWSBE utilization related to design and construction of the **2017** bond projects is **46.73%** of which includes 20.23% (\$182,311,465) participation by minority contractors, 22.73% (\$204,863,532) by women contractors and 3.78% (\$34,068,350) participation by small business contractors. This accounts for more than \$421 million of utilization by Minority, Women and Small Business Contractors.

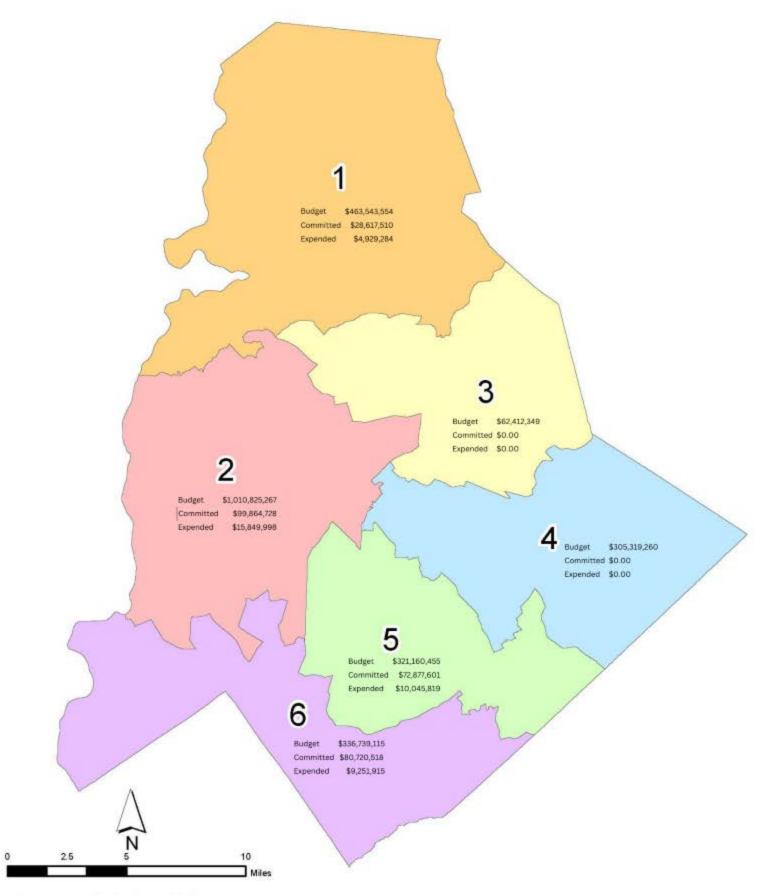
